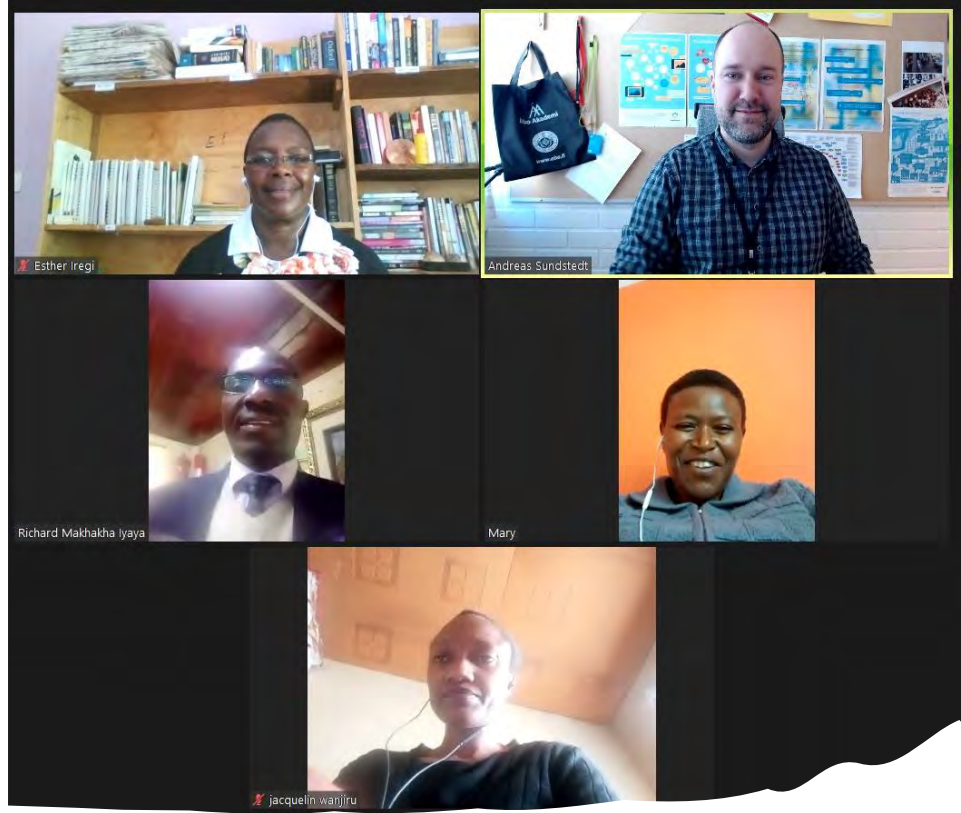

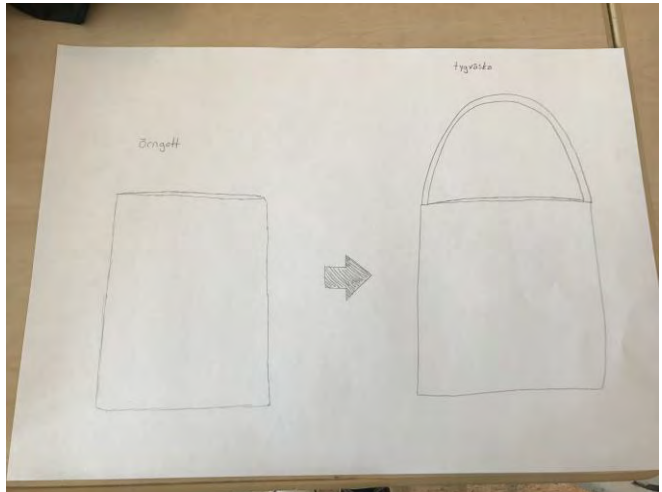

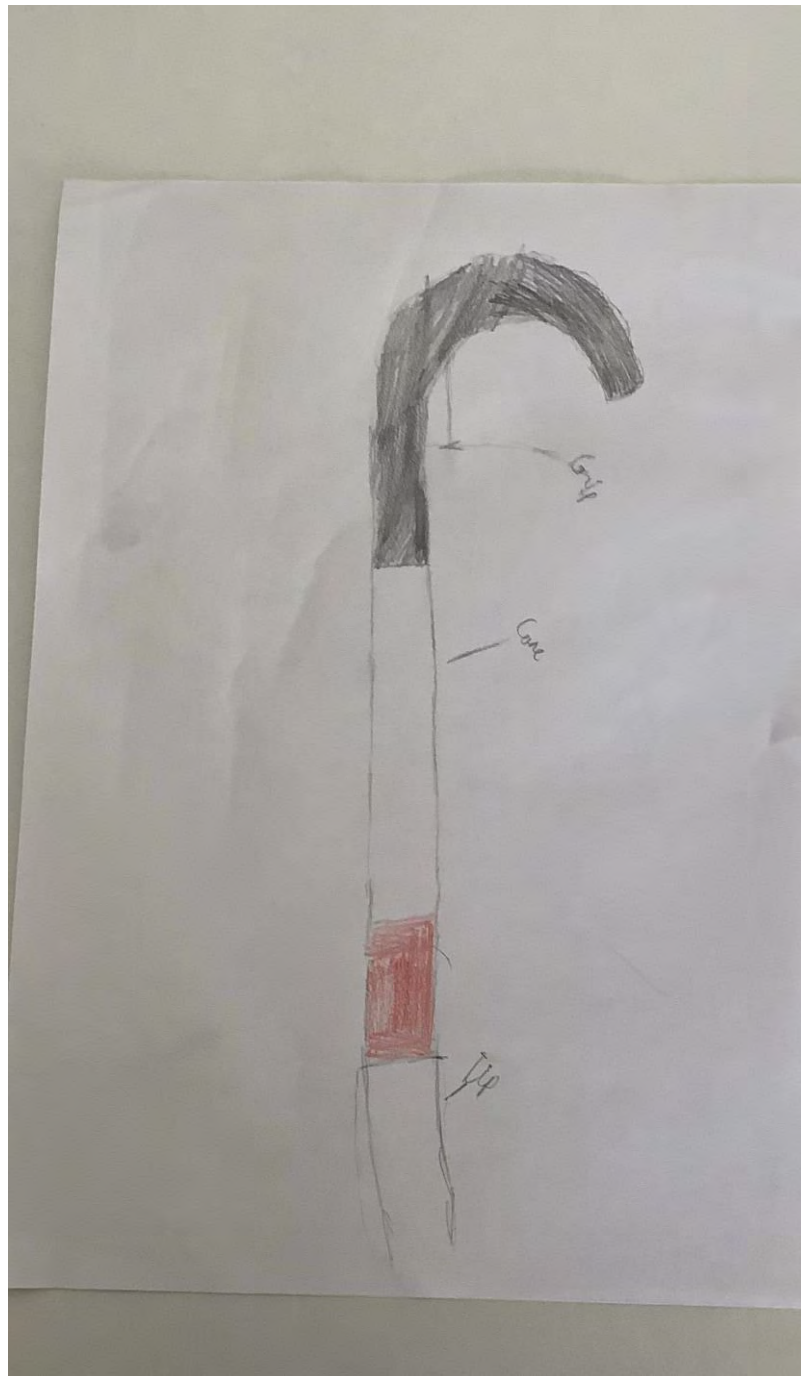

Rules of Procedure, VÖS Model UN 2022

Roles and Responsibilities

States	Eight States are present at VÖS Model UN 2022. They should act in accordance with how their real-world equivalents might act in the actual UN General Assembly.
Delegates	Each State is represented by 3 or 4 Delegates. These may decide to split responsibilities between them to function effectively. All Delegates are encouraged to give a speech, statement or reply during the MUN proceedings, although this is not mandatory.
Chair/Chairperson	The Chair in the UN General Assembly is held by the President of the General Assembly. He or she is the Chairperson during proceedings. There might be Vice-Chairs who step in during the Chair's absence, making them Chairman during that time.
Secretary	This position is held by the Secretary-General of the UN. The Secretary brings up issues for discussion and ensures proper documentation of the proceedings.
